Review of Membership: 1988-2020

Less than one-third of PACDAC's 53 members from 1988-2020 were women (15). Only two of PACDAC's nine deputy chairs were women.

Approx. 15% of PACDAC members were Maori, Moriori, Pacific Islander or persons of colour. Only one deputy PACDAC chair was Maori.

30% of PACDAC members were academics (16 people), 20% were former politicians (12), and 19% were activists (10).

At least four PACDAC members were "veterans" including a former Secretary of Defence, of which three served as deputy PACDAC chair.
